

Cleveland HS BPA Holiday Bazaar 2022 Vendor Indemnity Contract

(Please read carefully before accepting)

By accepting this agreement, Vendor(s) agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Cleveland High School Band Parents Association and Cleveland High School of Johnston County, sponsors, employees, volunteers and all associated with the named event, and others who occupy any position from any claims, injuries, damages, loss of actions caused or suffered by the participants arising out of the activity or participation of Vendor's connection with this event and any future participation. Vendor also agrees to save and hold harmless all aforementioned from any and all damages of, or loss to personal property inclusive of all rental areas for display and effects of the Vendor stored or used during this or any event. Acceptance releases sponsors and all others from any and all financial liability or obligation while participating in any or all events.

By submitting your registration, the Vendor agrees to follow criteria for display, location and rules set forth by management, either verbally or in writing inclusive of "Rules for Event". Failure to do so will result in Vendor being removed from the premises with no refund.

This waiver also releases to Cleveland High School Band and legal sponsors associated with this event the use of photos to be had with no monetary distribution or compensation to the signed applicant or others; which will be used strictly for future press or advertising purposes. Absolutely **no refunds** provided for Vendor's cancellation. Show hours are subject to change; pre-registered participants will be notified.

Rules

- **No** alcohol, tobacco, e-cigarettes (vapes) or pets allowed on premises.
- Vendor space is reserved on a first come basis. Early registration increases your chance of getting your preference, including electricity (we have a limited number of spaces available with electrical connections). Registration is not complete until payment is received. Booth space is selected by you during registration.
- Full disclosure of items being sold must be made on the registration form.
- **No** vendor will be allowed to sell food or beverages for immediate consumption. The Band Parent Association (BPA) will be serving concessions and lunch.
- **All** Johnston County Public School policies must be followed. Nothing explicit, obscene, vulgar or inappropriate will be sold. No alcohol, tobacco, or e-cigarettes (vapes) will be brought onto school property.
- Each vendor is expected to provide a raffle donation of at least a \$10 value that appropriately reflects the business.
- Vendors can set up on Friday, December 2nd (6-8PM), or Saturday, December 3rd (7-9AM).
- Vendors should park only in the designated area on Saturday to make room for our patrons.

- We are excited to welcome local vendors and invite the community. Our goal is to provide an exceptional experience for both vendors and patrons.
